Traders from the late 19th and early 20th century encouraged adoption of some kilim motifs into Navajo designs. Navajo Weaving - Cameron Trading Post The "late classic" era in Navajo weaving thus ended and the "transitional period" was begun. These "transitional" blankets varied widely in their artistry and quality. Some traders bought the blankets by the pound, causing the entrepreneurial Navajo to fail to wash the grease from the wool and to make additions of sand and lard to add to the weight.
